

Youth Code Of Conduct

To provide the best possible experience for everyone, the following are expectations for all participants:

- I understand and will abide by the rule that no male is allowed in areas assigned to females and that no female is allowed in areas assigned to males.
- I will remain on the event premises for the entirety of the event.
- I will not cause deliberate damage to cabins, facilities, or the property of others, and I will keep the event premises clean.
- I will respect all others and will not use profane or abusive language.
- I will dress modestly at this event. Some examples of inappropriate dress include: tube tops, sports bras, short shorts, bare midriffs, see-through clothing, fishnet-style clothing, and any absence of clothing.
- I will leave all cell phones, video games at home. I will only listen to my Ipod when driving to camps/retreats or going to sleep at night. I recognize that I am taking a risk of my ipod being damaged or stolen by bringing it to this event.
- My actions will display an attitude respectful of others.
- I will follow all times on the event schedule; no activity will begin until all are present.
- I will respect time and be where I am supposed to be for events and lights out.
- I will not change room assignments. (In event of an emergency or other need to contact any participant, staff must know where each person can be located.)

Failure to comply with the following points in the Code could result in dismissal from the event. ***Your parent or legal guardian will be responsible for your transportation home.***

- I will not bring or possess any weapons (including knives of any kind) or fireworks.
- I will obey all the laws of the State of Colorado and/or the state of the event.
- I will not possess or use alcohol or illegal drugs. Smoking or the use of any tobacco products is prohibited during the event.
- I understand that gross defiance of event staff directives or youth staff authority may be grounds for dismissal.
- I understand that sexual indiscretion or harassment in any form is prohibited.

I have read and I understand this Code of Conduct. I agree to abide by this code and other rules, which may be made for the general welfare of all camp participants. Furthermore, I am aware that my failure to abide by these rules or laws may result in my being denied the privilege of participation.
